JULY 24: DRIVE IN HILLSBORO (RSVPS NEEDED BY JULY 21). OVCC HAS BEEN INVITED TO JOIN THE "HILLSBORO DRAFT HORSE GROUP" FOR A DRIVE AT GALEN AND LYNN NEAL'S AT 5826 S.R. 138. (CALL 937-288-2682 OR 937-763-0636 OR 937-763-1000 OR 937-750-9700). **DIRECTIONS:** GO EAST ON US ROUTE 50 TO HOAGLAND (JUST BEFORE HILLSBORO): S&K ICE CREAM/MINIATURE GOLF ON RIGHT IN HOAGLAND: TURN RIGHT JUST BEFORE THE ICE CREAM PLACE ONTO MAD RIVER ROAD; TRAVEL ABOUT 2 MILES. MAD RIVER INTERSECTS WITH S.R. 138; TURN RIGHT ON 138. NEAL'S HOME IS LOCATED $\frac{3}{4}$ MI WEST, ON THE LEFT JUST PAST THE SOUTHERN BAPTIST CHURCH. SIGNS WILL BE PUT OUT. **FROM I-275:** TAKE S.R. 32 EAST; JUST PAST THE WILLIAMSBURG EXIT IS DE LA PALMA ROAD; TURN LEFT ON DE LA PALMA, STAY ON THIS ROAD (NO TURNS) THROUGH BUFORD AND DANVILLE; NEAL'S PLACE IS ON THE RIGHT ABOUT 3 MI EAST OF DANVILLE.
